

Interior doors

Interior doors are made mainly of MDF bearing material where natural veneer (beech, oak, spruce, pine, alder, and many more) is fixed. The material is steady to size (doors do not bend, narrow or stretch by the effect of damp, dryness at the change of conditions in the interior). It is impossible to distinguish from a massive material with naked eye, by means of that a perfect replacement of massive doors has been achieved. Doors are surface adopted either by means of indurated polyurethane lacquers or by means of recently more preferred ecological lacquers on the basis water in wide scale colour shades. The part of the door is also veneered door lining which has more variable versions of thicknesses and various shapes of cross-sections.

Interior doors can be either opening or sliding.
